

Joseph J. Rossbach, 87, died April 14.

Joe was a design engineer in the M.U.D. Engineering Department when he retired in 1989 with 38 years of service. He served in the U.S. Army and graduated from Purdue University before joining M.U.D. in 1950 as a cadet engineer in Water Operations.

During his career, he served as a construction engineer, administrative assistant to the General Manager, superintendent of Water Distribution, and supervisor of Engineering Operations.

Joe was a lifetime member of the American Water Works Association. He chaired the Nebraska Section in 1962 and received the Fuller Award in 1979. He served in the Army Reserve and the Nebraska National Guard, and was active in church and community organizations.
