Credit toward recertification for **water operators (Grades 1-4)** – 5 hours and **wastewater** – TBA hours for attending a day-long seminar.

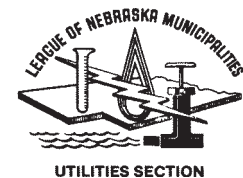
Registration and Fees
