





# The One AWWA Operator Scholarship



The **One AWWA Operator Scholarship** is funded through the support of AWWA's The Water Equation Campaign and the Nebraska Section.

### **PURPOSE of AWARD**

AWWA's The Water Equation Campaign and the Nebraska Section AWWA (NSAWWA) will award two **One AWWA Operator Scholarships** in the amount of \$1,000 each for Water Operator training and education.

Scholarship award can be used for certification/licensure, two- or four-year water related associate degree, technical school program, professional training program, books and manuals, and operator related conferences.

Each scholarship recipient will receive a one-year AWWA Operator membership.

### **ELIGIBILITY/GUIDELINES**

- Applicant must be a current water operator or seeking to enter the water operator profession.
- Applicant must be pursuing an Operator's License or Certification, two or four-year degree related to the water operator profession, or professional development.
- Disbursement of the funds will be made directly by the Section to the financial office of recipient's college, university, or technical school, or reimbursable upon proof of expenditures.
- Items related to books, manuals, conferences, professional development courses, and other eligible expenses will be reimbursed to recipient upon presentation of eligible receipts.
- Applicant must reside or work within the geographical boundaries covered by the sponsoring Section.
- Acceptance of scholarship constitutes permission to use recipient's name and scholarship story for purpose of promotion.

## APPLICATION PROCESS: DEADLINE/SELECTION/PRESENTATION

Deadline extended! Now Oct. 15, 2020

- 1. Applications are required to be submitted to the NSAWWA Scholarship Committee Chair (Angel Lowery -- alowery@olsson.com) by the end of the day on September 15 of each year.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded at the NSAWWA Banquet, during the annual Fall Conference, in Kearney, Nebraska, typically in November.
- 3. Scholarship recipients will be required to provide a follow-up report or write up, which is a one-page summary of how funds were used and how the recipient benefited from the scholarship. This document shall be received by the NSAWWA Scholarship Committee Chair by September 1 of the year following scholarship receipt.
